

HEALTH SYSTEM IN PANAMA

- Public Sector
 - MinSa (Ministerio de Salud-Health Ministry)
 - CSS (Caja del Seguro Social-Social Security)
- Private Sector

MINSA is the regulatory body and Rector of the National Health System, which also includes private medical services and paramedics.

The services covered by this system include, among others:

- a) Outpatient Facilities: for primary care (or first level of technical sophistication for problem solving) and generally bear the responsibility of health promotion, monitoring environmental work and vaccinations in the 97 districts in the country.
- b) Hospitals for mixed attention of first and second level of technical complexity and problem solving.
- c) Hospitals of third level of technical complexity, and a Central Health Reference Laboratory.



This Social Security Fund was created in March 21, 1941, based on constitutional provisions and by Act No. 23 of that year. This institution provides health-care assistance in case of illness, disease, occupational accidents and Maternity, and also provides economic benefits through the Program of Disability, Retirement and Death.

Therefore, the Public Health System of Panama is a mixed system with a tendency to progressive incorporation into a fully integrated one, through a gradual coordination, towards the integration of all care benefits and promotion of human and environmental health care, health surveillance and others.








Clinical Cases Management

We provide clinical cases management, optimizing diagnostic and therapeutic also centralize orientation; we hospitalization services, for example, in the case of crew members from ships or cruise line and airline passengers in any of the major local hospitals, perform therefore we consolidated billing, assuring that the charges offered are justified and in complete order.





Corporative Medicine

Since 1973, Clinica Einstein provides preemployment medical evaluations for several companies. We also coordinate periodic medical examination for international agencies employees, including cruise lines, embassies and consulates accredited by the Panamanian government; we also serve foreign and local companies like hotels, shipping agencies, banks, pharmaceutical agencies, insurance companies, and airlines. We do physical exams for seafarers from ships of several flag states.



Aviation Medicine

Civil aviators, i.e. pilots, stewardesses and/or flight attendants, also air traffic controllers and crew members, of commercial or private Airlines, from helicopters or fixed wing aircrafts, require medical certification to request or renew their aeronautical license. The aviation medicine includes aeromedical certification of pilots and crew members, as well as the evaluation and medical escort of some patients that travel on this type of craft.

Here at Clinica Einstein, for several decades we have performed this evaluations and certifications for different national and international airlines.





Maritime Medicine









Medical Expertise
